The Voters FIRST Act (Proposition 11, November 2008) and supporting regulations require the California State Auditor to select, by random drawing, eight applicants from the pool of qualified applicants to serve on the 2020 Citizens Redistricting Commission. The drawing to select the first eight commissioners shall be on July 2, 2020 at 10:30 a.m.

According to the California Department of Public Health, gatherings pose an especially high danger of transmission and spread of COVID-19. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the more people an individual interacts with at a gathering and the longer that interaction lasts, the higher the potential risk of becoming infected with COVID-19 and COVID-19 spreading. In addition, the Governor's Office and state public health officials previously announced that gatherings of individuals who are at higher risk for severe illness from
